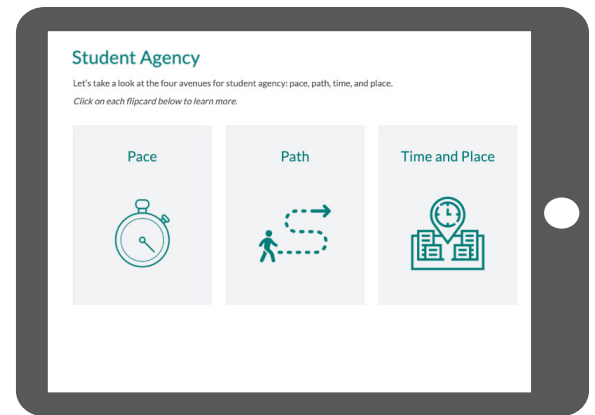

Creating Community in Online Classrooms
