3. (Required) Please describe a project incorporating videoconferencing technology completed within the last year. (200 words max)
4. For each of the following please provide evidence which may include website links, presentations, videos, testimonials, etc.
 - a. (Required) How has your project made a positive impact on your educational community (whether that's locally, regionally, statewide, nationally, or worldwide)
 - b. (Required) How does your project plan for and incorporate the use of videoconferencing technology for the purpose of enhanced learning?
 - c. (Required) How do you continuously improve professional practice through the exploration of creative applications for video conferencing technology? How do you reflect upon and evaluate this?
 - d. (Required) How do you promote the effective use of digital tools across local and global learning communities?
 - e. (Required) How do you exhibit leadership in your school and/or professional community with a vision of furthering videoconference technology infusion, collaboration, and/or community building?
 - f. (Required) How has the use of IVC empowered your work?
 - g. (Required) How does your work promote the ISTE Standards?
