- 4. (Optional) If desired, include the contact information for an additional reference.
- (Required) Briefly describe your learning space project. Tell us about the impact it has had on your learning community. How has your space impacted students in terms of achievement, motivation, and/or meeting competencies? How is technology incorporated? (500 words max)
- 6. (Required) Please provide a URL that points to information about your learning space project. This could be related to the planning and implementation and where you are in the project, even if the project is not yet completed. At minimum this must include images of the learning space, but could also include planning documents, supporting websites and images, or video.
- (Required) Please describe how you specifically led and/or supported the innovative use of space. How did you get funding? How did you convince stakeholders to commit? What research or best practices did you use in the design? (500 words max)
- 8. (Optional) Please discuss how you have communicated what you have done to others. Either within your school or other venues such as workshops or conferences.
- 9. (Optional) Is there anything else you would like the judges to know about your use of learning space? (500 words max)
