

ISTE Literacy Network Spotlight Literary Practice Award

This award recognizes an educator who has developed an exceptional technology-supported literacy practice suitable for replication by colleagues.

The following questions will be asked on this award form:

1. (Required) Please upload a current CV or Resume
2. (Required) Please provide a brief biography of yourself and your work (500 words max)
3. For the following questions, please offer for consideration an original or original modification/personalization of a known instructional practice or approach.
 - a. (Required) Please describe the significant learning goal the practice or approach addresses. (500 words max)
 - b. (Required) Please give a clear, full description of the practice: What's done? What's accomplished? What's the significance? (500 words max)
 - c. (Required) Please describe how the practice is implemented. (500 words max)
 - d. (Required) Please upload evidence of implementation (photos or captures of materials, the practice in implementation, student work samples, etc)
 - e. (Required) Please describe the replicability of the practice: Can colleagues replicate implementation of the practice? What would be needed to do so? Provide links to any ancillary online tutorials that would support implementation. (500 words max)
 - f. (Required) Please provide a letter of endorsement of the practice by an instructional supervisor and/or colleague (a short statement assuring that the practice has been implemented and is worthy of note and replication by colleagues).

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
